Key Responsibilities, tasks and Activities

- a) To lead the delivery of the academy physiotherapy services
- b) To assist delivery of soft tissue and physiotherapy needs of the academy and developing squad players under the guidance of the Senior Squad Physiotherapists.
- c) To assist the Senior Squad Physiotherapists with daily assessment / treatment requirements.
- d) Working to an appointment system for player soft tissue and physiotherapy treatment.
- e) To assist with the weekly recovery services as required.
- f) Ensure the physiotherapy treatment room is kept in an impeccable manner, with all appropriate equipment and bedding sanitised and hygienic.
- g) Assist in the delivery of matchday services at home and away fixtures as required.
- h) Deliver small group mobility / Prehabilitation sessions under the guidance of the Senior Squad Physiotherapists
- i) Deliver 1:1 rehabilitation sessions under the guidance of the Senior Squad Physiotherapists
- j) Data entry to enable consistent correlation against incidence of injury under the guidance of the Senior Squad Physiotherapists daily.
- k) Lead on injury management and rehabilitation of the academy players
- I) Organise staffing for the Cardiff Rugby Academy, Cardiff RFC and age grade teams under the guidance of Head of Medical Services / Senior Squad Physiotherapists
- m) Lead match day physiotherapy services for Cardiff Rugby Academy / Cardiff RFC matches under the guidance of the Senior Squad Physiotherapists
