1: Eligibility

This competition is open to residents of the United Kingdom aged **5 to 15 years old** (inclusive) at the time of entry, except for employees of Cardiff Rugby, their immediate families, or anyone professionally connected with this competition.

All entries must be submitted by a parent or legal guardian on behalf of the child.

2. How to Enter

Submit your child's shirt design by email to: competition@cardiffrugby.wales

Deadline: Monday, June 16

Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted.

3. Design Requirements

Entries must:

- Be the child's original work
- Not include any third-party logos, trademarks, or copyrighted material
- Be free from:
 - Offensive, defamatory, or inappropriate content
 - References to illegal, unsafe, or irresponsible behaviour

Cardiff Rugby reserves the right to amend or remove entries that do not comply with these guidelines.

4. Judging and Winner Selection

A judging panel appointed by Cardiff Rugby will select one winner based on:

- Creativity
- Originality
- Suitability for Cardiff Rugby branding
- The panel's decision is final
- The winner will be notified by email as soon as possible after June 16.
- If the winner cannot be reached within **five (5) working days**, a replacement winner may be selected.

5 Prize Details

- The winning design may be produced as an official Cardiff Rugby training shirt.
- Cardiff Rugby reserves the right to modify the winning design to meet branding and manufacturing standards.
- The prize is non-transferable and no cash alternative will be offered.
- Travel or expenses associated with the prize are not included.
- Cardiff Rugby may substitute the prize with one of equal or greater value if necessary.

6 Intellectual Property & Permissions

By entering the competition, parents/guardians:

- Confirm the design is the entrant's own original work
- Grant Cardiff Rugby a royalty-free, worldwide, irrevocable licence to use the design in print, online, and promotional materials
- Agree that the club may adapt the design as needed
- Understand that the child's first name, age, and design may be published, subject to consent

- Personal data will be used solely for the purpose of administering the competition.
- Entrants must remain subscribed to the Cardiff Rugby mailing list until the competition closes.
- All data will be processed in accordance with Cardiff Rugby's Privacy Policy

- Only parents or legal guardians may submit entries.
- By entering, the parent/guardian confirms they consent to the child's participation and agree to these terms.
